# RSV cases

- **January to June 2017: number of cases 770  
percentage of positive cases 7% (54/770)**
- **All recruited patients had a fever or a history of fever**
- **Cases without fever , not recruited**
- **Underestimation of RSV incidence in Cote d'Ivoire**

**Fever being the first reason for consultation in ARI cases, where and how to recruit RSV cases without fever**

- **In the community ?**
- **At the hospital?**

# Conclusion

- **We have an influenza surveillance network that can help to monitor RSV without significant additional modification or cost.**
- **The establishment of a network dedicated to RSV will allow us to collect data specifically related to what we need to know about RSV**
